Swarm is an European Space Agency (ESA) mission to study the Earth's magnetic field. High-precision and high-resolution measurements of the strength, direction and variations of the Earth's magnetic field, complemented by precise navigation, accelerometer and electric field measurements, will provide data essential for modelling the geomagnetic field and its interaction with other physical aspects of the Earth system.


The three Swarm spacecraft have been launched on November 22nd 2013 on board of a Rockot launch vehicle from the Plesetsk Cosmodrome (Russia).

SPC Sotis took part in the magnetic field measurements (EMC tests) during the launch campaign, providing a valuable contribution to the preparatory activities of the satellites.

While performing such activities, SPC Sotis personnel demonstrated their solid professional skills and flexibility, tackling and solving all the encountered technical problems and respecting the schedule constraints dictated by the launch campaign schedule.
